CINAHL Plus Full Text **FULL TEXT**

Provides full text for more than 560 journals and indexing for 1,835 journals from the fields of nursing and allied health, including biomedicine, alternative and complementary medicine, consumer health and 17 allied health disciplines.

Health and Wellness Resource Center **FULL TEXT**

Provides access to up-to-date reference material as well as full-text magazines, journals, and pamphlets from a wide variety of authoritative medical sources.

Health Reference Center Academic **FULL TEXT**

An advanced interface to the full-text nursing and allied health journals found in the Health and Wellness Resource Center database.

Health Source: Consumer Edition **FULL TEXT**

Full text for 160 journals including Consumer Reports on Health and Men's Health, as well as abstracts and indexing for nearly 180 health publications.

Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition **FULL TEXT**

Provides the full text of 550 scholarly journals, including 450 peer-reviewed journals on medical disciplines, with full text from as far back as 1975. Includes Clinical Pharmacology, which provides drug monographs for all U.S. prescription drugs, herbal and nutritional supplements, and over-the-counter products.

MEDLINE with Full Text **FULL TEXT**

Full text for nearly 1,200 journals, as well as abstracts and indexing for 4,000+ current biomedical journals, with coverage dating back to 1965.

Nursing and Allied Health Source **FULL TEXT**

Access articles and graphics from more than 270 nursing-related publications.

Physicians Desk Reference (PDR) **FULL TEXT**

Index of drugs and medications. Search by product name, manufacturer, product category, indications, contraindications, side effects, or drug interactions.

PsycArticles **FULL TEXT**

Provides full-text, peer-reviewed scholarly and scientific articles in psychology from 56 journals. Coverage spans 1985 to present.

Thomson Healthcare Series **FULL TEXT**

Access gateway to several Thomson Healthcare products including MICRO-MEDEX Health Care, CareNotes System, and the PDR Electronic Library.



DATABASES

These databases provide the full text of articles that were originally published in magazines, journals, and newspapers.

They are available to currently enrolled Florida community college students, anywhere those students can access the Internet.



GETTING THERE

Go to LINCCWeb at www.linccweb.org. Click **Search a Specific Database**, then:

- ◆ Pick **Central Florida Community College**
- ◆ Enter your 9-digit **Borrower ID** and your **PIN** (last 4 digits of your ID)
- ◆ At the next screen, select **Health and Medicine**

LINCCWEB DATABASES

There are 80+ LINCCWeb databases, most of which provide the full text of at least some of the articles indexed in the database. "Full text" means that you can view (or print or email) the complete article, not just a summary or information about the article. The full-text articles that you access through the LINCCWeb databases are the exact same articles that were published in the original print version of the magazine or journal or newspaper or reference book, so that is how they are categorized for research papers. Not every database provides full-text articles, so it's important to choose a database that does if you need the actual articles. In the list of databases, the ones that provide actual articles say **Full Text** next to the title, and most databases offer the option of limiting your search to Full Text.
